## **Artlink Pacific Participated in Mission Healthy Greens Vegetables Donations Program**

### **Background of Mission Healthy Greens Vegetable Donation Program**

The Mission Healthy Greens Vegetable Donation Program (MHGVDP) was initiated in 2013 to donate organic vegetables or local accredited vegetables (新界信譽菜) to the elderly and other underprivileged individuals. In fiscal year of 2013/2014, Mission Healthy Greens donated approximately 1,600 catty of organic vegetables to the community.

### **Artlink Pacific Donated vegetables to those in need**

On 10 June, 2015, Artlink Pacific (Artlink) and Mr & Mrs Mai Tong both provided a generous donation to support the MHGVDP. A total of 120 bags of organic vegetables were donated to 180 residents of Fung Tak Estate Estate which they were also given the free dinner boxes ‘愛心飯盒’.

In addition, Artlink formed a volunteer work team and worked hand-in-hand with Mission Healthy Greens’ (MHG) staffs and volunteers to engage in different community services.
